Requirements

- At least 50 classes (100+ hours) of guided teaching experiences using Voz Alta curriculum and methods, including lesson plans. At least 35 of these classes will be larger groups of 6 students or more
- Develop 1 Curriculum Module
- Teach 3 classes with no lesson plan or materials
- Teach 2 classes without speaking
- Attend 3 required trainings (free): Popular Education, Teatro Oprimido, Community Resources
- Join ORTESOL (Oregon Teachers of English to Speakers of Other Languages) \$20 a year
- Teach a sequence of least 5 classes in 3 different sites (one multilingual and one monolingual site)
- Write a short paper (less than 5 pages) on "The Kind of Teacher You Are"

Work with groups of 6 or more
